


Q1. How quickly can you deliver a seat?

A. Broxap have a wide range of seats in various materials available from stock. Any seats which are indicated by the  logo are available within 7 working days. Other seats within the range are generally available within 3-4 weeks, however Broxap will endeavour to meet any reasonable delivery requirement.

Q2. Out of what materials are seats manufactured?

A. Seats are available manufactured from the following materials: Cast Iron, Timber, Mild Steel, Recycled Plastic, Concrete, Stainless Steel - Examples of all seats are illustrated in the Specifier's Directory.

Q3. What sizes are the seats available in?

A. The majority of seats are 1800mm in length and have seating heights ranging from 420mm – 500mm. Other sizes of seat are available within the range together with bespoke options on request.

Q4. Are you able to supply replacement slats?

A. Yes, replacement slats are available for all seats in our range.

Q5. Are slats available in different materials?

A. Yes, the majority of seats are available with various slat options including: Timber (various types), Steel, Recycled Plastic and Stainless Steel.

Q6. What is the expected lifespan of a cast seat such as the Eastgate?

A. With correct maintenance the castings should last in excess of 100 years. Hardwood slats should have a lifespan of approx 15 years.

Q7. Is the timber used by Broxap from a sustainable source?

A. Yes, all timber used in our seating range is from a sustainable source. Broxap are able to provide Forestry Stewardship Certification on request.

Q8. Which type of seat is the most vandal resistant?

A. The seats within our mild steel range are most suitable for areas prone to vandalism additionally the seats within the cast range are available with mild steel anti vandal slats and ductile iron seat ends.

Q9. Can seats be supplied with nameplates and logos?

A. Yes, seats within the cast iron range may have logos cast integrally in to the seat ends and are also available with a brass dedicatory plaque. Timber seats are also available with a brass dedicatory plaque and may also have an inscription routed into the backrest. Plaques may also be fitted to the mild steel range together with laser cut logos on request.
