## **TFL CONTRACT 2004-2005**



Broxap have been awarded the major part of the “Term contract for the provision of cycle parking facilities at Schools and Colleges”. This initiative sponsored by Ken Livingstone (Mayor of London) is designed to provide facilities in schools in Greater London for pupils so that they are encouraged to cycle to school. Part of the initiative to reduce traffic volumes it is hoped that cycling to school, which gives health benefits, will extend into pupils adult life. The contract commenced in January 2004 is expected to continue for about 2 years

Broxap designed a new range of shelters 5 metres long with Sheffield stands at 900mm centres giving 10 cycles per shelter. The shelter is long enough to accommodate 2 banks of helmet lockers so that pupils can safely store their helmets in the shelter. The shelters are modular and can be extended to any length. Under the contract Broxap survey each site and are responsible to deliver, provide foundations or concrete bases and install the shelters. Each site is left clean and tidy.

Phase 4 of the TFL contract will be completed by the end of December 2005.
